



ABBATRON COMPLIANCE DOCUMENTATION & CUSTOMER SUPPORT POLICY

Halsit Holdings, LLC dba Abbatron

Purpose

This policy defines the scope of regulatory compliance documentation and customer-specific compliance support provided by Halsit Holdings, LLC dba Abbatron. It is intended to establish a consistent, scalable process for customers, distributors, and other business partners requesting regulatory or material-compliance information.

Published Compliance Documentation

Abbatron maintains current company-level compliance statements and reporting documents on the Certifications & Compliance Statements webpage. These include, where applicable, RoHS, REACH, California Proposition 65, TSCA, PFAS, Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP), Conflict Minerals, and the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT). The current documents published at <https://www.abbatron.com/certifications-compliance-statements> represent Abbatron's controlled revisions and supersede previous published versions.

Standard Reporting Scope

Unless otherwise established by written agreement, Abbatron provides compliance information at the company level based on supplier-provided information, internal product knowledge, known product specifications, and reasonable due diligence. Because many Abbatron products are sold through authorized distribution, company-level compliance statements are intended to support the majority of customer requirements across thousands of catalog products.

Product-Level and Customer-Specific Documentation

Abbatron does not routinely maintain or provide product-level Full Material Declarations (FMDs), product-level CMRT or EMRT reports, IPC-1752 declarations, SKU-specific smelter traceability, product-specific REACH or PFAS declarations, product-specific Proposition 65 exposure determinations, or customer-specific spreadsheets and questionnaires. When product-specific documentation or special reporting is required, the requirement should be identified and agreed to in writing at the time of purchase. Abbatron does not routinely maintain part-level Full Material Declarations unless specifically contracted.

Customer Portals and Third-Party Systems

Abbatron does not routinely register with or access customer or third-party compliance portals, supplier networks, or reporting systems, including systems such as Assent, IMDS, BOMcheck, or similar platforms, unless specifically required by written agreement. Standard published compliance documents should be used whenever they satisfy the requested regulatory requirement.

Post-Purchase and Custom Documentation Requests

Requests submitted after the original purchase for custom certifications, product-specific declarations, questionnaires, spreadsheets, material call-outs, or other customer-specific reporting may require administrative, engineering, supplier, or records-review work. Such requests may be subject to a fee beginning at \$175.00, with the final charge based on the scope and complexity of the request.



Completion of a custom request is subject to the availability of reliable supporting information and does not obligate Abbatron to provide data that is not reasonably available within its supply chain.

Regulatory and Document Updates

Compliance statements are reviewed periodically and may be updated as regulations, industry reporting tools, supplier information, or product requirements change. Customers should rely on the current revisions published on the Abbatron website rather than archived or previously downloaded copies.
