This statement includes consideration of substances and restrictions contained in the current Annexes to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, including applicable restrictions concerning PFOS, PFOA, PBDEs, and other Persistent Organic Pollutants regulated under the Stockholm Convention.

Abbatron does not perform analytical testing for all POP substances on every product and relies upon supplier declarations, material information, and reasonable supply-chain due diligence. As a manufacturer and supplier of electronic and electromechanical components, Abbatron does not maintain homogeneous-material-level Full Material Declarations for all catalog products unless specifically required by written agreement.

We will continue to monitor changes to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 and update this statement as appropriate.
