RoHS	Directive 2011/65/EU and amendments, including (EU) 2015/863. Where applicable, compliance may use allowable RoHS exemptions identified in the current statement.
REACH	Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, including the ECHA SVHC Candidate List, the 0.1% w/w threshold, and Annex XVII restrictions.
California Proposition 65	Addresses potential exposure to listed substances in materials such as brass, plated metals and plastics; warning obligations depend on end-use exposure conditions.
TSCA	Addresses applicable U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act requirements, including Section 6(h) restrictions for persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals.
PFAS	PFAS Compliance and Disclosure Statement based on supplier information and known specifications; products using PTFE or other fluoropolymers should not be represented as PFAS-free.
Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP)	Addresses Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 and subsequent amendments using supplier-provided material information and reasonable due diligence.
Conflict Minerals	Responsible-sourcing policy for tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3TG), including RCOI where appropriate, RMI tools and OECD-aligned due-diligence principles.
RMI CMRT	Company-level Conflict Minerals Reporting Template reflecting available supplier and smelter/refiner information. Complete smelter-level traceability is not represented for every product or material.
