



TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT (TSCA) COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

TSCA Section 6(h) - Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals

Halsit Holdings, LLC dba Abbatron is committed to compliance with applicable requirements of the U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), including restrictions established under TSCA Section 6(h) for persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals.

The five PBT chemicals addressed by EPA under TSCA Section 6(h) are:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

EPA amended the regulations for decaBDE and PIP (3:1) in 2024, including revised restrictions, exclusions, phase-in periods, workplace requirements, and a 0.1% by-weight threshold for unintentional amounts of these substances in products and articles.

Based on information provided by our suppliers and to the best of our knowledge, the five PBT substances listed above are not intentionally added to Abbatron products during our manufacturing processes.

Abbatron relies on supplier-provided material information and does not routinely perform analytical testing for substances that are not intentionally added.

This statement is based on information reasonably available to us and reflects our current understanding of applicable TSCA Section 6(h) requirements. Abbatron will continue to monitor regulatory developments and update this statement as needed.
