



Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Halsit Holdings, LLC dba Abbatron is committed to responsible sourcing and ethical business practices. We expect our suppliers to uphold similar standards regarding the sourcing of minerals used in their products.

Conflict minerals refer to **tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (3TG)** originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries, which may directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups.

As a manufacturer and distributor of electronic components, Abbatron does not directly source raw materials and relies on its supply chain to provide information regarding the origin of 3TG materials.

A **Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI)** is conducted in alignment with the **OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals**. Supplier information is collected using the **Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT)**.

Based on the information provided by suppliers, complete traceability to smelters or refiners is not available at the company level. Therefore, it cannot be conclusively determined whether all 3TG materials originate from the DRC or adjoining countries.

Suppliers are expected to:

- Support responsible sourcing initiatives
- Provide accurate and current CMRT data upon request
- Avoid sourcing from entities that contribute to conflict

Reasonable efforts are made to ensure that materials are sourced responsibly, and ongoing engagement with suppliers is maintained to improve transparency within the supply chain.
