Statement of Compliance:

Abbatron certifies that its products labeled as RoHS compliant conform to Directive 2011/65/EU and its amendments, including Directive (EU) 2015/863. Where applicable, compliance is achieved through the use of allowable exemptions as defined under current RoHS directives.

RoHS Exemption Declaration (EU RoHS Pack 22 Update):

Abbatron confirms that certain products may utilize materials covered under allowable exemptions of Directive 2011/65/EU and its amendments, including recent updates under RoHS Pack 22.

Exemption 6(c): Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight - Expiration Date: July 21, 2026

Exemption 6(a): Lead as an alloying element in steel (where applicable) - Expiration Date: July 21, 2026

These exemptions are currently valid and are applied only where technically necessary.

Abbatron continues to monitor regulatory developments and will update compliance status as exemptions are revised or approach expiration.
